

Hydro-Meteorological Modelling

Visiting Research Fellows

The Joint Centre for Hydro-Meteorological Research (JCHMR) brings together researchers from the Met Office and the Centre for Ecology and Hydrology Wallingford (previously the Institute of Hydrology) working on the hydro-meteorology of rainfall, soil moisture and flood forecasting and of climate change moisture feedbacks and impacts. The JCHMR has set up a fund to support Visiting Research Fellows working at the Centre for periods of 3 to 12 months. Fellowship awards will cover additional costs (living costs and travel but not salary).

Candidates for fellowships will have an established reputation in their specialist field, and wish to work on research at the interface between hydrology and meteorology. They should be experienced modellers enthusiastic to work in the collaborative research environment provided by the Centre.

Fellows will benefit from the shared CEH and Met Office facilities available at the Centre, providing access to data, models, computing and national hydrological and meteorological science libraries. The JCHMR enjoys a pleasant rural setting by the banks of the River Thames and the small market town of Wallingford, with the city of Oxford 12 miles to the north.

Interested applicants should submit a concept note on their proposed research activity and period of appointment together with a CV.
